

## **Bloomfield**

- Obit of David E. Chambers d. 10/16/2009, son of Stanley Cyrus Chambers of Bloomfield Farm.
- PC of group family reunion, 1870.
- Newspaper article, "Outdoor Report" by Pat Burton, undated, mentioning booklet, *Bloomfield* by John T. Chambers, describing mills along E. branch of Red Clay Creek.
- Eleven-page PC of *Bloomfield* by John T. Chambers (1842 - ?), dated 1917, with information on various mills on property on E. Branch of Red Clay Creek. Booklet measures 4.5" by 6".
- 49-page book (PC), *Bloomfield 1817-1870*, dated 1920, with names and photos of 1920 reunion with reminiscences. Explains "fulling mill," page 21; origin of Bloomfield name: General Bloomfield, 1812 encampment; drawing of "the old mill"; list of attendees at 1870 Reunion; mentions Ashmead Woods, p.33; Fairthorne, p. 36; old songs, pp. 36-37; John Agnew and Harlan Gause, p. 37. Lots of valuable history.
