

MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

OF KENNETT TOWNSHIP

801 Burrows Run Road

June 15, 2009

Chairman Hammaker called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m., with Vice-Chairman Falcoff present Supervisor Elling was absent.

Mr. Hammaker moved that the minutes of the May 18, 20 and 27, 2009 and June 3 and 10, 2009 meetings be approved as distributed. Mr. Falcoff seconded the motion and it carried with both Supervisors in favor.

ANNOUNCEMENTS AND REPORTS

- 1) Mr. Falcoff presented the public safety information data, gave the June 2009 Accident Summary as follows:

May, 2009 accidents:

- 71 accidents YTD vs. 98 last year during the same period - for a 27.6% OA reduction. (It will be interesting at year end to see if the accident rate reduction is due to decreased volume.)
- 14 accidents during May vs. 22 in May of last year.
- 1 accident on Kaolin Rd. at Chandler Mill Rd. This is the 2nd month in a row for accidents at this intersection.
- 1 accident at Rosedale and McFarlan.
- 1 accident at Rosedale and Bayard.

Miscellaneous:

- The Rt. 82/US1/Cedarcroft potential U-turn modification south of the intersection, on Rt. 82, has run into a problem: there are probably gravesites in the poorly defined PennDOT right-of-way.
- We did not receive a PA "Smart Transportation" grant for turn-lanes at the Rt. 52/Hillendale intersection and Rt. 52 Bikeway improvements. This will not stop us from installing basic signalization at the intersection.
- We have applied for Federal Stimulus Phase II Grant money for the Rt. 52 Bikeway/Hillendale turn-lane work. (There are 18 in-county projects competing for the money allocated to Chester County.)

Police Activity

- 39 calls responded to from Chester County Police Radio.
- 3 criminal investigations.
- 29 routine assignments.

- 2 alarm activation calls (5.1% of overall activity).
- 5 automobile accidents responded to.

There were 84 State Police incidents in addition to KTPD activity in May, with 19.1% being false burglar alarm responses.

NEW BUSINESS

Doug Fearn of the Lyme Disease Association of Southeastern PA gave a presentation on Lyme Disease.

SUBDIVISION/LAND DEVELOPMENT PLANS

Extensions

Mr. Hammaker moved to approve the following extension: 1) D'Agostino Property until 9/1/09. 2) Shepherd Property CU Hearing until 9/1/09. Mr. Falcoff seconded the motion and it carried with both Supervisors in favor.

OTHER BUSINESS

Mr. Hammaker stated that a Conditional Use Hearing was held on May 18, 2009 for the Sparre Property located on Route 52. **Mr. Hammaker moved to approve the Conditional Use Hearing decision. Mr. Falcoff seconded the motion and it carried with both in favor.**

Per Capita Tax

Mr. Hammaker moved to accept the Per Capita Tax removals per memo dated May 19, 2009. Mr. Falcoff seconded the motion and it carried with both Supervisors in favor.

ADJOURNMENT

Mr. Hammaker acknowledged receipt of the financial statement for the prior month. **Mr. Hammaker moved that the bills be approved for payment, seconded by Mr. Falcoff, with all Supervisors in favor.**
