The work session was called to order by Chairman Falcoff with Vice-Chairman Elling and Supervisor Hammaker both present.

Bill Hewton discussed the mission of his group KTRGG with the Board, discussed their proposed letter regarding the mission statement of the group and activity and asked for the Boards reaction. The Board replied that they will not edit or comment on the letter since it is a private political group not a Township volunteer group and they may do as they wish with it. Bill Hewton asked if the Board would be willing to post a letter from their group on the Township website and the Board replied that they will consider it. Bill Hewton stated that the group will be submitted suggestions for changes and updates on the Township website. Lisa Moore stated that John Haedrich should be involved in the discussions on the website since he assisted in creating it.

Lisa Moore discussed the Public Meeting Agenda with the Supervisors, the trailer at Kennett Medical, Route 1 Business Corridor meeting, Kendal ground breaking and the Whiteside/Beer proposal.

Allan Falcoff discussed the proposed HUD/Retirement Ordinance from the Planning Commission, the flashing signal at McFarlan & Rosedale Roads, the hunting ordinance, the Library/YMCA/Anson Nixon Park project and the need to get the Library representatives to the next work session.
