The work session was called to order by Chairman Falcoff with Vice-Chairman Elling and Supervisor Hammaker both present.

The Supervisors met with Jane Dorchester of Chester County Historic and Sara Meadows of the Historic Commission and agreed to complete phase I of the proposed Red Clay Creek Historic District for Kennett Township only.

Mr. Hammaker moved to approve the Red Clay Creek Historic District proposal for phase I not to exceed \$5,520.00. Mr. Falcoff seconded the motion and it carried with all in favor.

Mr. Hammaker moved to approve an extension for the Flower Farm/Dewson property until November 20, 2016. Mr. Falcoff seconded the motion and it carried with all in favor.

The Supervisors met with Tom and Sandy Mills and Ron Denadai, engineer, to discuss the Chandler Mill Bridge and that PennDOT has recently rehabbed one lane bridges. The Supervisors agreed to write a letter in support of rehabbing the bridge if possible.

Lisa Moore discussed the request from the After the Bell program for a donation and the Supervisors agreed to contribute \$1k, the Department of Defense request that the Supervisors sign a statement of support for the Guard and Reserve and the Board agreed and discussed the set up of funds for the Township.

Allan Falcoff discussed the proposed property maintenance code and instructed Lisa Moore to advertise for adoption.
