AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KENNETT, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF KENNETT TOWNSHIP TO AMEND THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS AND THE MEMBERSHIP QUALIFICATIONS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE KENNETT TOWNSHIP TRAILS AND SIDEWALKS COMMITTEE; REPEALING ALL INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2014, the Board of Supervisors of Kennett Township enacted Ordinance No. 218 which established the Kennett Township Trails and Sidewalks Committee consisting of five (5) members; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to increase the membership of the Trails and Sidewalks Committee to seven (7) members, and wishes to state the qualifications of the members of the Trails and Sidewalks Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that increasing the membership of the Trails and Sidewalks Committee is in the best interest of the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of Kennett Township by allowing the Committee to obtain additional input from members of other Township committees and residents of the Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it, and it is hereby **ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors of Kennett Township, and it is hereby **ENACTED** and **ORDAINED** by authority of same as follows:

I. Section 12-15 of the Code of Ordinances of Kennett Township is amended to read as follows:

“§12-15. Membership; Qualifications.

The Trails and Sidewalks Committee shall consist of seven (7) persons, at least three (3) of whom must be Township residents appointed by the Board of Supervisors of Kennett Township which shall include: At least one (1) member of the Land Conservancy Advisory Committee (Township Resident), at least one (1) member of the Planning Commission (Township Resident), two (2) community members (at least one of which is a Township Resident), one (1) member of the Land Conservancy, and two (2) members of the Kennett Trails Alliance. Appointment to the Trails and Sidewalks Committee will be based on either knowledge of the subject of trails and/or sidewalks, professional experience with trails and/or sidewalks, or knowledge of and willingness to serve the community.”

II. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.

III. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such determination shall have no effect on the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or on the provisions of the Code of Ordinances of Kennett Township.

IV. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days following its legal enactment.
