## **Kennett Township Supervisors to hold public meeting to update residents on Lisa Moore embezzlement**

*Meeting scheduled for Tuesday, December 7 at 7:00 p.m. at Township Building*

**KENNETT TOWNSHIP** \_ The Board of Supervisors of Kennett Township is holding a public meeting to update the public concerning the Lisa Moore embezzlement of township funds.

The public meeting will be held Tuesday, December 7, 2021, at 7:00 p.m. at the Township Building, 801 Burrows Run Road, Chadds Ford, PA 19317. Those attending should wear face masks. The meeting will also be shown via Zoom. The Zoom link to the meeting can be found on the township's website, [www.kennett.pa.us](http://www.kennett.pa.us).

In October, Lisa Moore, a former township manager, pled guilty in Chester County Common Pleas Court to stealing \$3.2 million. She was sentenced to 3-to-10 years in prison and ordered to spend an additional five years on probation while making restitution to the township.

"Almost two years ago, the township Board of Supervisors held a public meeting to give information on the investigation and arrest of Moore. At the upcoming public meeting, the Supervisors will give the public an update on what has taken place since that first public meeting," said Supervisors Chair Richard Leff.

The elected officials have also been giving residents updates at all Supervisors meetings twice a month.

Leff added, "Since the discovery of Moore's theft, the administration of the township has been difficult and challenging. The public meeting on December 7 is designed to shed light on the steps taken by the Supervisors to keep the township functioning during this troubling period of township history."
